A RESOLUTION concerning

Interdepartmental Transfer of Appropriations

For the purpose of transferring surplus appropriations reflecting savings from the Office of Information Technology and Communications, Police Department, and Non-Departmental accounts to the Fire/EMS Department and Board of Elections.

WHEREAS, CB-28-2008, as amended, adopted and enacted the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance of Prince George's County for Fiscal Year 2009, which set forth the amount of appropriations and revenue estimates, said appropriation and revenue estimates to be adjusted as hereinafter set forth; and

WHEREAS, CB-28-2008, the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance of Prince George's County for Fiscal Year 2009 was subsequently amended by CB-51-2008; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 814 of the Charter of Prince George's County,
Maryland, the County Council may, upon recommendation of the County Executive, transfer
appropriations between agencies of the County government within the same fund of the current
expense budget; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has duly recommended that the transfer of appropriations be made.
