This Act makes changes to Subtitle 11, Division 5 of the County Code and will require that the members of the Fire Commission be appointed by the County Executive and confirmed by the County Council. It will provide for representation on the Fire Commission from County volunteer fire departments, the Fire/EMS Department, and the general public. Additionally, it will expand the duties of the Fire Commission to allow it to play a more active role in the provision of Fire and EMS services to the County.
