RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 The Formation of an Agricultural District pursuant to the
3 Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation Program
4 For the purpose of recommending that the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation
5 approve the petition of The Richardson Family Limited Partnership to establish an agricultural
6 district.

7 WHEREAS, a petition filed on May 21, 2004 by The Richardson Family Limited
8 Partnership requested the establishment of an agricultural preservation district for approximately
9 312.5781 acres of land on the south side of Aquasco Farm Road, as generally shown on the
10 attached location map; and

11 WHEREAS, the petition was referred to the Prince George's County Planning Board and
12 the Prince George's County Agricultural Preservation Advisory Board for review and
13 recommendation; and

14 WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Planning Board found that establishment of the
15 proposed agricultural district is compatible with existing and approved county plans and
16 recommended approval the petition and establishment of the district; and

17 WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Agricultural Preservation Advisory Board found
18 that The Richardson Family Limited Partnership property met the qualifying criteria for
19 productivity, size, and location as set by the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation
20 Foundation, and recommended establishment of the agricultural district; and

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
22 County, Maryland, that Parcels 5 and 6 of the 312.5781 acre tract described in the agricultural

1 district petition filed by The Richardson Family Limited Partnership is recommended to the
2 Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation for approval; and

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution, copies of the petition, and copies of the
4 letters from the Agricultural Preservation Advisory Board and the Prince George's County
5 Planning Board, be forwarded by the Clerk of the Council to the County Executive for his
6 consideration and, upon his approval, transmittal to the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation
7 Foundation for appropriate action.
