RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

Revitalization Tax Credit – The Towers at University Town Center

For the purpose of establishing that a high rise multifamily student housing development known as The Towers at University Town Center, located in census tract number 805901 qualifies for a revitalization/redevelopment tax credit pursuant to Section 10-235.02 of the Prince George's County Code.

WHEREAS, Section 10-235.03 of the Prince George's County Code the County established a Revitalization Tax Credit District comprised of all census tracts wherein the median household income does not exceed one hundred percent (100%) of the median household income for the County based upon the 2000 census; and

WHEREAS, Section 10-235.02 of the Code allows a developer of new multifamily dwellings to apply for a tax credit upon a finding by the County Council that the development lies within one of the above-referenced census tracts, and will promote redevelopment within the community; and

WHEREAS, application has been made by developers certain property being Parcel J, Prince George's Metro Center as per plat thereof recorded among the land records of Prince George's County, Maryland on March 7, 2005 in Plat Book REP 205 as Plat No. 41, Real Estate Tax Account Number 366674-0, referred to as The Towers at University Town Center project (hereinafter the "Applicant") to develop a high rise multifamily student housing development located within census tract number 805901 on Belcrest Road between Maryland Route 410 and Toledo Road in the City of Hyattsville in Councilmanic District 2; and

WHEREAS, census tract number 805901 lies within the Revitalization Tax Credit District

1 set forth in Section 10-235.03 of the Code; and 2 WHEREAS, the student housing units will provide needed student housing within the range 3 of affordability for students within the Revitalization Credit District and the rental of these units 4 will promote redevelopment within the census tract. 5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the proposed development of 244 units of high rise multifamily student 6 7 housing, known as The Towers at University Town Center, and located on Belcrest Road in 8 Hyattsville, Maryland, is hereby found to be eligible for the redevelopment/revitalization tax 9 credit set forth in Section 10-235.02 of the Prince George's County Code.
