RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Statewide Specialized Transportation Assistance Program

3 For the purpose of authorizing the filing of an application with the Maryland Transit

4 Administration of the Maryland Department of Transportation for the Statewide Specialized

5 Transportation Assistance Program, Section 5311 grant under the Federal Transit Act.

6 WHEREAS, the Maryland Transit Administration is the designated recipient in Maryland
7 for grants under the Federal Transit Act; and

8 WHEREAS, the Administrator of the Maryland Transit Administration of the Maryland
9 Department of Transportation is authorized to make grants to counties and to local governments
10 for a mass transportation program of projects; and

11 WHEREAS, the Maryland Transit Administration requests a resolution be submitted with
12 all grant applications by the local jurisdiction; and

13 WHEREAS, the contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon the
14 applicant, which includes the local share of the project costs in the program; and

15 WHEREAS, it is required by the United States Department of Transportation in accordance
16 with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 that, in connection with the filing
17 of an application for assistance under the Federal Transit Act, the applicant give an assurance
18 that it will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the United States
19 Department of Transportation requirements thereunder; and

20 WHEREAS, it is the goal of the applicant that minority business enterprise be utilized to
21 the fullest extent possible in connection with this project, and that definite procedures shall be
22 established and administered to ensure that minority business shall have the maximum

1 construction contracts, supplies, equipment contracts, or consultant and other services.

2 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
3 County, Maryland, that the filing of the aforesaid application is endorsed.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Council of Prince George's County is by
5 endorsing this application indicating approval thereof; and that copies of this resolution be sent
6 to the Maryland Transit Administration of the Maryland Department of Transportation.
