LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

COMMITTEE-OF-THE-WHOLE

Committee Vote: Favorable as amended, 5-0-0 (In favor: Council Members
Castaldi, Casula, MacKinnon, Mills and Pemberton)

It was noted that an indoor shooting range is currently permitted in
the I-1, I-2 and C-M Zones, and M-NCPPC supports the legislation. Ed
Gibbs, of Gibbs and Haller, spoke in favor of the legislation.

Councilman Castaldi proposed that the legislation be amended to state
that there must not be any discernible noise from the outside of the
building. The Committee accepted this amendment.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT**(Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)**

There is a need to locate an indoor shooting range, to be utilized by the private sector and public safety officials in the I-4 Zone. Currently, this use is permitted in the I-1 and I-2 Zones and prohibited in the I-3 and I-4 Zones. This legislation will permit an indoor shooting range in the I-4 Zone.
