(a) Participation	n Prohibitions Except as permitted by Roard regulations or opinion an

official or employee may not participate in:

(1) Any matter, except in the exercise of an administrative or ministerial duty which does not affect the disposition or decision with respect to that matter, if, to [his] their knowledge, [he] they, [his] their spouse, parent, child, brother, or sister has an interest therein.

* * * * * * *

- (2) Post employment limitations and restrictions.
- (A) With the exception of former members of the county Council, a former official or employee may not assist or represent any party other than the county for compensation in a case, contract, or other specific matter involving the county if that matter is one in which [he] they significantly participated as an official or employee. A specific matter may be one in which there is the same basic facts, related issues, and information, involving the same or related interest, as well as other considered factors.
- (B) Until the conclusion of [one] <u>three TWO</u> calendar years from the date the official leaves County office, a former member of the county council may not assist or represent another party for compensation in a matter that is the subject of legislative action.
- (C) A former member of the County Council may not assist or represent another party,

 WHETHER for compensation OR NOT, in any judicial or quasi-judicial proceeding in which
 they substantially SIGNIFICANTLY participated in or voted on as a member of the County

 Council.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection, or section.
