This resolution amends the Salary Plan of the County to reflect the terms of a labor agreement by and between Prince George's County and Local #1619, International Association of Firefighters, AFL-CIO for FY1990-92. The Salary Schedule "S" reflects the economic modifications of the labor agreements.

The Office of Law has reviewed the resolution and find it to be in proper legislative form without legal impediments to its adoption.

The fiscal impact on the County is \$13,608,535 for the three year agreement. The breakdown is as follows:
