EXPLANATION OF GRANT ADJUSTMENTS

Health Department

The Health Department received additional funding for several existing grant programs totaling \$1,307,851. In addition, the Department received \$1,000,000 in Federal funding through the Council of Governments to enhance hospital bed surge capacity to meet the needs of the National Capital Region, \$18,680 in State funding to implement a suspension reduction program for ninth graders at High Point High School, and finally the agency received funding to facilitate better management of on-site disposal systems in the amount of \$49,151 through the Coastal Zone Program.

Office of the Sheriff

The Office of the Sheriff has been awarded State grant money for the Project Safe Neighborhoods program, which is intended to increase enforcement in the CSAFE communities and other major gun corridors within the County.

Department of Environmental Resources

The LID National Conference Phase II program is a continuation of the current Low Impact Development (LID) grant from the Environmental Protection Agency in the Anacostia River Watershed. The purpose of the grant is to initiate and implement a community LID and trash management plan to demonstrate how simplistic techniques can improve the water quality of storm water runoff while improving the community's quality of life.

Department of Housing and Community Development

The agency has received additional funding totaling \$300,000 for the Housing Opportunities for Persons with Aids Program.

Police Department

\$167,042 in additional Federal funding has been awarded to the Police Department for several existing grant programs. State funding totaling \$85,000 for programs has also been awarded to the Department. Included in the total state funding amount is \$50,000 for the School Video Program which will assist with costs to produce training videos.

Office of Human Resources and Management

The Senior Aide Employment program received \$39,400 in additional funding to support the current program.

Office of Homeland Security

The Office of Homeland Security received Federal funding totaling \$897,674 to enhance the capabilities of State and local emergency responders by allowing the purchase of advanced types

of equipment to enhance homeland security.

Non-Departmental

The Livable Communities/Private Partnership program is receiving \$1,000,000 in funding through an inter-agency grant as well as funding from outside sources to support the County's Livable Communities Initiative.

Department of Corrections

The Department of Corrections received funding to support the Mental Health Assessment Program in the amount of \$20,800.

Fire/EMS Department

The Fire/EMS Department received additional funding in FY 02 and School Video money in FY 04.

Circuit Court

The Circuit Court received funding for Foster Care Court improvements.

Department of Family Services

The Department of Family Services received School Video money for FY 04.
