BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission Capital Budget
 3 For Fiscal Year 1999-2000 and Capital Improvement Program for Fiscal
 4 Years 2000-2005

5 For the purpose of amending the Prince George's County portion of the Maryland-National
 6 Capital Park and Planning Commission Capital Budget for Fiscal Year 1999-2000 and Capital
 7 Improvement Program for Fiscal Years 2000-2005 to add one development project to the
 8 Commission's Capital Budget.

9 WHEREAS, Article 28, Section 2-118 (b) of the Annotated Code of Maryland provides for
 10 the amendment of the Capital Budget and Capital Improvement Program of the Maryland-
 11 National Capital Park and Planning Commission by the County Governing Body on its own
 12 initiative or at the request of the Commission and after public hearing upon reasonable notice to
 13 the public; and

14 WHEREAS, the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission has requested
 15 an amendment to the Prince George's County portion of the Maryland-National Capital Park and
 16 Planning Commission's Capital Budget for Fiscal Year 1999-2000, adopted by CB-27-1999, and
 17 Capital Improvement Program for Fiscal Year 2000-2005, as adopted by CB-28-1999, to include
 18 the addition of one development project to be funded by a developer contribution; and

19 WHEREAS, the development project is the Junior Tennis Champions Center; and

20 WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended to the County Council this
 21 amendment; and

1 WHEREAS, the County Council has conducted a public hearing on the proposed
2 amendment having given reasonable notice thereof; now, therefore,

3 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
4 Maryland, that the Prince George's County portion of the Maryland-National Capital Park and
5 Planning Commission's Capital Improvement Program for Fiscal Years 2000-2005, as adopted
6 by CB-28-1999, is hereby amended to include the project as shown in Exhibit A attached hereto
7 and made a part hereof.

8 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the Fiscal Year 1999-2000 Capital Budget
9 of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission, as adopted by CB-27-1999,
10 Appendix B, is hereby amended to increase the amount in the Commission's Capital Budget by
11 \$5.5 million in accordance with the following schedule:

18 SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the funding for this project shall be
19 derived from a developer contribution.

20 SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)
21 calendar days after it becomes law
