For the purpose of	f requesting the Public Service Commission to impose a moratorium on utility
price increases for	the indefinite future.
WHEREAS,	Title 4, Subtitle 1, Section 4-102 of the Public Utilities Article, Annotated
Code of Maryland	l permits the Public Service Commission to set just and reasonable rates for a
public service con	npany, as maximum rate, minimum rate, or both; and
WHEREAS	, service rates within Prince George's County and the State of Maryland have
continued to incre	rase; and
WHEREAS, residents in Prince George's County are facing unprecedented challenges in	
affording essentia	l services; and
WHEREAS,	these escalating utility costs are placing an undue burden on low- and
moderate-income	households; and
WHEREAS,	a comprehensive review of the causes for the rise in rates should be conducted
to ascertain the ne	ecessity of the current rates.
NOW, THE	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
County, Maryland	l, that the County Council requests that the Maryland Public Service
Commission initiate a moratorium on all utility price increases for an indefinite period of time.	
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon commencement of the moratorium, the County	
Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, requests that the Maryland Public Service	
Commission conduct a thorough review of the factors contributing to the rate increases and	

determine if the increases are justified and equitable.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, requests that the Maryland Public Service Commission partner with Pennsylvania-New Jersey-Maryland Interconnection (PMJ) to conduct a comprehensive review of policy mechanisms that may lower utility rates that directly affect ratepayers in Prince George's County and the State of Maryland.
