**REPORT:**

Committee Vote: Favorable 3-0 (In favor: Chair Adams-Stafford, Council Members Dernoga, and Olson)

The Education and Workforce Development Committee convened on May 11, 2026, to consider CB-037-2026, an act concerning the Apprenticeship Incentive Program for the purpose of requiring Employ Prince George's and other relevant County agencies to work to strategically provide a package of incentives to increase the prevalence of apprenticeships across Prince George's County, and particularly in industries including technology, construction, building trades, and healthcare.

The Policy Analysis and Fiscal Impact Statement noted that the enactment of CB-037-2026 would have a slightly adverse fiscal impact on the County due to the cost of establishing and administering the apprenticeship incentive program. Additionally, it was noted that taxes collected from employees of apprenticeship programs could provide additional revenue for the County.

The County Executive's office supports the bill, and the Office of Law found the bill to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its enactment.

Employ Prince George's, Inc., supports the bill as long as a collaborative plan with the County is in place.

On May 11, 2026, the Education & Workforce Development Committee voted favorably on CB-037-2026, 3-0.
