A RESOLUTION	concerning		
	Redevelopment Authority		
For the purpose of amending the Capital Improvement Program of the Redevelopment Authority			
of Prince George's County, to include the two vacant office buildings at 5801 and 5809			
Annapolis Road, Bladensburg and authorizing the exercise of the power of eminent domain by			
the Redevelopmen	nt Authority.		
WHEREAS, the establishment of the Redevelopment Authority of Prince George's County			
("Redevelopment Authority") was authorized by CB-85-1997 pursuant to Chapter 266 of the			
Laws of Maryland, 1996, both of which are codified in Subtitle 15B of the Prince George's			
County Code (the	"County Code"); and		
WHEREAS, the Charter of the Redevelopment Authority was approved by the County			
Council by CR-60	0-1998 and duly filed with the State of Maryland; and		
WHEREAS, Section 15B-124 of the County Code provides that the Redevelopment			
Authority of Prince George's County may propose one or more projects for inclusion in the			
Redevelopment Authority's Capital Improvement Program and that the County Executive shall			
transmit to the County Council for its approval by resolution or ordinance any such project			
approved by the C	County Executive; and		
WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Authority's Capital Improvement Program was adopted by			
CR-17-2000; and			
WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Authority proposes to amend its Capital Improvement			

Program to include two vacant office buildings known as 5801 and 5809 Annapolis Road,

Bladensburg (the "Annapolis Road Properties"), in need of revitalization; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of its Charter, the Redevelopment Authority has the power to do the things necessary in connection with the Redevelopment Authority's participation in this project as such powers are specified under Chapter 266 of the Laws of Maryland and Subtitle 15B of the County Code, including the power to acquire by eminent domain; and

WHEREAS, at a meeting of the Redevelopment Authority held on October 4, 1999, the Redevelopment Authority approved the proposed rehabilitation and renovation of the Annapolis Road Properties subject to certain conditions; and

WHEREAS, the conditions have been satisfied and the Redevelopment Authority adopted a Resolution on July 10, 2000, the (the "Redevelopment Authority Resolution"), attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference, which Resolution included a proposed Amendment to its Capital Improvement Program to specifically identify the Annapolis Road Properties, (which Amendment has been submitted to the County Council by the County Executive); and

WHEREAS, Section 15B-106 (c) of the County Code provides that land taken through the exercise of the power of eminent domain by the Redevelopment Authority pursuant to a delegation of authority from the County is declared to be needed for a public use or benefit; and

WHEREAS, the acquisition of the Annapolis Road Properties by eminent domain is necessary to facilitate the rehabilitation and renovation of the property and to provide an impetus which private enterprise cannot provide; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 15B-121 of the County Code, the exercise of the power of eminent domain by the Redevelopment Authority must have the prior approval of the County Council by resolution and the concurrence of the County Executive; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has indicated his concurrence in the redevelopment proposed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Redevelopment Authority's Capital Improvement Program, as adopted by CR-17-2000, be and the same is hereby amended to include the Annapolis Road Properties identified as "Bladensburg Redevelopment", CIP ID No. UM900975.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the proposed rehabilitation and renovation of the Annapolis Road Properties, be and the same is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Annapolis Road Properties are hereby declared to be needed for a public use or public benefit.
