REPORT: Committee Vote: Favorable 4-0 (Councilmembers: Toles, Harrison, Lehman, and Turner)

The Public Safety and Fiscal Management (PSFM) Committee convened on July 8, 2014 to interview Mr. Nicholas A. Majett, Esq. as the nominee to be the Chief Administrative Officer for Prince George's County. Currently, he serves as the Acting Chief Administrative Officer.

As the Acting Chief Administrative Officer, Mr. Majett oversees the day to day operation of the County Government. He has over 25 years of experience in public administration and management, with expertise in consumer and regulatory affairs oversight, budget planning and implementation, contract review, tax policy and litigation.

Prior to joining the County government, Mr. Majett served as the Director of the Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs for the District of Columbia.

Mr. Majett received his Bachelor of Science degree in Political Science from Howard University and the Juris Doctorate from Howard University School of Law.

The nominee gave a presentation to the members of the PSFM Committee on his qualifications, experience and ability to implement the County Executive's initiatives on behalf of the citizens and residents of Prince George's County.

The members of the PSFM Committee had an in- depth discussion with the nominee on issues concerning his role and future as the Chief Administration Officer and ways to enhance the economic development of the County and address consumer regulatory issues.

The members of the Public Safety and Fiscal Management Committee voted 4-0 favorable, to recommend the appointment of Mr. Majett as the Chief Administrative Officer of Prince George's County.
