Committee Report

Committee Vote: Favorable, 3-0 (In favor: Council Members Wineland,

Del Giudice and MacKinnon)

Frank Stegman of Labor Relations, Captain Daniel Husk and Police Chief David Mitchell were present for the worksession. This legislation will shorten the time period to appeal promotional exam questions from 12 working days to 5 working days. The legislation will also shorten the time period the Joint Appeal Board shall have to review all appealed questions from 20 working days to 7 working days.

## BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT (Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)

This bill is to approve the amendments to the County's collective bargaining agreement with the Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge #89, Inc. Specifically, the County and F.O.P. 89 have entered into a Memorandum of Understanding to shorten the time period relating to appeals of promotional written examination questions, thus expediting the scheduling of promotional oral boards. The process will be shortened from in excess of nine calendar weeks to about six calendar weeks.
