BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 The Classification Plan for Prince George's County

3 For the purpose of assigning certain existing classes of work to the bargaining unit represented
 4 by Prince George's Correctional Officers' Association, Inc. (PGCOA) (Civilian Unit).

5 WHEREAS, the County Executive, pursuant to Section 903 of the Prince George's County
 6 Charter and Section 16-125(a) of Subtitle 16 of the Prince George's County Code, has, in order
 7 to provide better governmental services, recommended to the County Council amendments to the
 8 Classification Plan for Prince George's County, Maryland with respect to certain classes of work
 9 described within Section 1 of this bill; and

10 WHEREAS, the County Executive, pursuant to Section 903 of the Prince George's County
 11 Charter and Section 16-125(a) of Subtitle 16 of the Prince George's County Code, has
 12 recommended to the County Council amendments to the Classification Plan for Prince George's
 13 County, Maryland with respect to the classes of work described within Section 1 of this bill, in
 14 accordance with the Certification of Representation issued by the Prince George's County Public
 15 Employee Relations Board (PERB) in Case Number 16 390 00467 02 for positions in the
 16 bargaining unit represented by Prince George's Correctional Officers' Association (PGCOA)
 17 (Civilian Unit) now, therefore,

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
 19 Maryland, that the Classification Plan for Prince George's County, Maryland be and the same is
 20 hereby amended as follows:

1236Q Supply Manager I, Q-18
(\$32,642 - \$51,159)

1237Q Supply Manager II, Q-21
(\$37,590 - \$59,024)

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law and shall be retroactive to August 31, 2004.
