RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 The Tax Rates for FY 2000-2001

3 For the purpose of imposing and levying the tax rates and causing to be raised the amount of
4 taxes required by the adopted budget so as to balance the budget as to proposed income and
5 expenditures for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000; to set forth the State tax levy and the
6 Stormwater Management District tax levy; and to adopt and impose a service charge for
7 semiannual payment of State, County, and special taxing district property taxes on owner-
8 occupied residential property.

9 WHEREAS, Section 817A of Article VIII (Budget and Finance) of the Charter for Prince
10 George's County, Maryland requires that when the County Budget shall have been finally
11 adopted in the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance, the Council shall, by separate
12 Resolution, levy and cause to be raised the amount of taxes required to balance the budget as to
13 proposed income and expenditures; and

14 WHEREAS, the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance, was adopted, transmitted to
15 the County Executive pursuant to Section 411 of the Charter, and has now become law; and
16 WHEREAS, the Current Expense Budget as submitted by the County Executive, an
17 authenticated copy of which, as amended, was incorporated by reference and made a part of the
18 Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance, will require the amount of taxes produced by the
19 levy of the rate as hereby set; and

20 WHEREAS, Sections 10-183 through 10-186 of the Prince George's County Code set forth
21 the procedures for the reduction of the rate of County property taxes levied in municipalities to

1 reflect the services and programs that are performed by the municipalities instead of similar
2 County services and programs; and

3 WHEREAS, Section 10-106 of the Prince George's County Code requires the levy shall be
4 set forth in such a manner as to show the total property tax rate and that portion of the rate
5 attributable to the budget for Prince George's County Public Schools; and

6 WHEREAS, the County must include in the annual property tax bills a State levy as
7 certified by the State Board of Public Works and a levy for the Prince George's County
8 Stormwater Management District; and

9 WHEREAS, state law requires that the Stormwater Management District tax be imposed
10 only upon properties that are provided either directly or indirectly stormwater management
11 services; and

12 WHEREAS, Section 10-204.3 of the Tax-Property Article, Annotated Code of Maryland,
13 requires that the County governing body shall provide a semiannual payment schedule for
14 property tax being collected by the County for itself or any other taxing authority, due on owner-
15 occupied residential property.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
17 Maryland, that there is hereby imposed and levied a tax upon each One Hundred Dollars
18 (\$100.00) of assessed value of all assessable property, real and personal, assessed according to
19 the Laws of Maryland and subject to taxation in Prince George's County, at the following rate:

20 Two Dollars and forty-one cents (\$2.410).

21 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the levy for the County property tax in
22 municipalities shall be adjusted as follows:

1 SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that included in the total County tax rate is
2 that portion attributable to the budget for Prince George's County Schools, at the following rate:

3 One dollar fourteen and forty five hundredth cents (\$1.1445)

4 SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the levy to be included on the annual tax
5 bill as submitted by the State Board of Public Works for the State tax for each One Hundred
6 Dollars (\$100.00) of assessed value is at the following rate:

7 Twenty-One Cents (\$0.2100)

8 SECTION 5. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the levy for the Prince George's County
9 Stormwater Management District for each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of assessed value
10 shall be at the following rate:

11 Taxing Area 1 - Thirteen and fifty hundredths cents (\$0.1350)

12 Taxing Area 2 - Three cents (\$0.0300)

13 SECTION 6. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the rate of tax levied and imposed by
14 this resolution for semiannual payment of State, County, and special taxing district property
15 taxes on owner-occupied residential property shall take effect and be in force for the fiscal year
16 beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.
