Committee Vote: Favorable, 5-0, (In favor: Council Members Estepp, Bailey, Hendershot, Wilson and Scott).

This Resolution and Salary Schedule C amendment will implement the Memorandum of Understanding of the collective bargaining agreement between the County and Council 67, American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees (AFSCME), AFL-CIO and its affiliated Local 3279.

The proposed amendment will provide for an earlier effective date for employees covered by Salary Schedule C to receive the 2.75% FY99 cost of living adjustment (COLA) in July 1998 instead of

October 1998.

The fiscal impact of this legislation is contained in CB-83-1998.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT**

**(Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)**

This is companion legislation to the Bill to approve the amendment to the current collective bargaining agreement between the County and Council 67, American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, and its affiliated Local 3279. This modification provides for the payment of the 2.75% cost of living increase in July 1998 rather than in October 1998. The estimated fiscal impact will be provided by the Office of Management and Budget.
