BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 The Classification Plan for Prince George's County

3 For the purpose of abolishing existing classes of work from the collective bargaining agreement
4 between the County, the State’s Attorney’s Office, and Service Employees International Union
5 Local 400PG, Salary Schedule V; and

6 WHEREAS, the County Executive, pursuant to Section 903 of the Prince George's County
7 Charter and Section 16-125(a) of the Prince George's County Code, has, in order to provide
8 better governmental services, recommended to the County Council amendments to the
9 Classification Plan for Prince George's County, Maryland with respect to the classes of work
10 described in Section 1 of this Bill; now, therefore,

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George’s County,
12 Maryland, that the Classification Plan for Prince George’s County be and the same is hereby
13 amended as follows:

7 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)

8 calendar days after it becomes law and shall be retroactive to [July 1] March 6, 2007.
