LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

COMMITTEE-OF-THE-WHOLE REPORT

Date: October 16, 1990

Committee Vote: Favorable, 8-0-0 (In favor: Council Members Bell, Castaldi, Casula, MacKinnon, Mills, Pemberton, Wilson, and Wineland)

Draft 2, which added a new subsection (b) to Draft 1 and renumbered the remaining subsections, was considered by the Committee. Subsection (b) requires a description in clear and specific terms of the emergency and the reason for the purported emergency.

Stan Fetter spoke in favor of Draft 2 and additional provisions which were included in CB-119-1990.
