#### **EXPLANATION OF ADJUSTMENT**

## **Department of Family Services**

Multi-Systemic Therapies, \$654,161, to provide services to juveniles at risk for out-of-home placement. Shelter Plus Care, \$79,195, to provide additional funding for the existing Shelter Plus Care program within the Core Service Agency. Senior Training and Employment, \$308,176, to offer low income seniors paid community service and training as an entry into productive work.

### **Health Department**

Public Health Emergency Preparedness – PHER IV, \$115,000, to support the Department's response efforts to the H1N1 virus.

## Office of the State's Attorney

Domestic Violence Support Grant, \$500, will provide support services within the Office.

## Fire/EMS Department

Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response (SAFER), 3,458,681, through the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, to provide funding directly to fire departments in order to increase the number of trained "front-line" firefighters available in their communities.
