Committee Vote, No Recommendation, 4-0, (In favor: Councilmembers Exum, Hendershot, Knotts and Peters.)

This bill is an Executive Order transferring the community mediation, community forum and Leadership Prince George's functions from the Human Relations Commission to the Office of Community Relations and certain related staff positions. The three staff positions are Community Developer III, Administrative Aide II and a part-time Community Developer III. The total cost for the three positions transferred is \$134, 300.

Section 16 of the Schedule of Legislation of the County Charter relating to the Office of Community Relations is amended to conform to the transfer of the three functions.

The Legislation is retroactive to July 1, 2003 and will become effective within 60 days after submission to the Council unless disapproved by a majority vote of the full Council.

The Committee requested job descriptions for the Community Developer positions and additional information on Leadership Prince George's from the County Executive's Office.

There should not be any negative fiscal impact on the County as a result of enacting CB-34-2003.
