(a) Pursuant to the prov	isions of Section 10-235.02 of this Code, there is hereby	
established a Revitalization Ta	ax Credit District which shall be comprised of all those census	
tracts situated wholly within the	ne boundaries of the Capital Beltway (Route I-95 and 495) located	
within the County, where the	median household income does not exceed one hundred percent	

(100%) of the median household income for the County, based upon the 1990 census.

- (b) Pursuant to the provisions of Section 10-235.02 of this Code, there is hereby established a Revitalization Tax Credit District which shall be comprised of census tracts 8015.00, 8019.05, 8022.03, 8022.04, 8036.05, 8036.10, and 8038.01.
- (c) In census tracts 8015.00, 8022.04, <u>8036.05</u>, 8036.10, and 8038.01 only nonresidential improvements shall be eligible for the tax credit.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
