Item Title: AN ACT CONCERNING FINE DINING INCENTIVE ACT OF 2026 for the purpose of establishing a Prince George’s County Fine Dining Incentive Program to attract more fine dining restaurants to locate and expand in Prince George’s County; reserving a certain percentage of annual awards from the Prince George’s County Economic Development Incentive Fund for the Prince George’s County Fine Dining Incentive Program; providing for the administration and regulation of the Prince George’s County Fine Dining Incentive Program; providing for the abrogation of the program; and generally relating to the Prince George’s County Fine Dining Incentive Program.

This Council Bill was presented by Chair Oriadha and referred to the Committee of the Whole.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

This bill would establish a Fine Dining Incentive Program, requiring a percentage of the funds annually awarded from the Economic Development Incentive (EDI) Fund to be used to attract and retain fine dining restaurants, as defined in the bill. The Program would be administered in accordance with existing EDI Fund administration processes and would include a focus on restaurants located inside the Capital Beltway. The bill would require annual reporting to the County Council on the Program's progress, and includes a January 1, 2030, abrogation provision.
