Committee Vote: Favorable as amended, 4-0, (In favor: Councilmembers Bailey, Scott, Estep and Maloney).

This legislation is a comprehensive review of Subtitle 7 of the County Code and includes a number of statutory provisions that have been preempted or superceded by subsequent enactment of state law.

A summary of the changes that cites the Rule or states general law that supercedes the existing County law contained in Subtitle 7 to support the deletion or, in a limited number of sections, the amendment or retention of the existing sections and the amendments to the juror compensation, are included in the Draft 2.

There should not be any negative fiscal impact on the County as a result of enacting CB-28-2001.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

The County Code includes a number of statutory provisions that have been preempted or superceded by subsequent enactment of state law. The proposed legislation is the result of a comprehensive review of Subtitle 7 of the County Code. Although most of the existing sections are proposed for repeal as either obsolete or replaced by state law, several sections are proposed for retention and amendment to conform to state law. A section-by section review has been prepared that provides citations to the appropriate provision of state law or court rules that have superceded the existing sections of the County Code.
