

1 WHEREAS, the Zoning Ordinance also provides a review period for the County Executive
2 and the District Council to review, provide written comments, and identify any inconsistencies
3 between the public facilities proposed in the Plan and any existing or proposed State or County
4 facilities including roads, highways, or other public facilities; and

5 WHEREAS, Section 27-645 provides that the adopted plan may not include a highway or
6 transportation line unless the District Council, after consultation with the County Executive,
7 approves (by resolution) the inclusion of the highway or transportation line for planning
8 purposes; and

9 WHEREAS, the Planning Board referred the public facilities element of the Preliminary
10 Subregion 1 Master Plan and Proposed Sectional Map Amendment for review, comments, and
11 the identification of any inconsistencies between the public facilities proposed in the plan and
12 any existing or proposed State or County facilities on July 23, 2009, attached hereto as
13 Attachment A; and

14 WHEREAS, upon review the District Council has concluded that, in general, the new and
15 modified public facility transportation proposals contained in the Preliminary Master Plan for
16 Subregion 1 are consistent with the County's Capital Improvement Program (CIP) and the
17 State's Consolidated Transportation Program (CTP).

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
19 County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington
20 Regional District in Prince George's County, that the transportation system and public facilities
21 proposals proposed in the public facilities element for the Preliminary Master Plan for Subregion
22 1, as transmitted on July 23, 2009, by the Prince George's County Planning Board, is approved
23 for the purpose of the inclusion of the proposed new transportation lines and public facilities in
24 the adopted plan; and

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council intends to further review the plan and its
26 public facilities element following the joint public hearing and receipt of the adopted plan from
27 the Planning Board, and may at that time revise the plan and its transportation system if changes
28 appear justifiable and consistent with long-range goals and objectives; and

29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Chairman
30 of the Prince George's County Planning Board.
