RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission

3 FY 1999 Capital Budget

4 For the purpose of amending the Prince George's County portion of the Maryland-National
5 Capital Park and Planning Commission Capital Budget for Fiscal Year 1998-1999 to transfer
6 appropriation authority to various projects.

7 WHEREAS, Article 28, Section 2-118, of the Annotated Code of Maryland provides for the
8 amendment of the Capital Budget of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning
9 Commission (the "Commission") by the County Governing Body on its own initiative or at the
10 request of the Commission and after public hearing upon reasonable notice to the public; and

11 WHEREAS, the Commission has requested an amendment to the Prince George's County
12 portion of the Commission's Capital Budget for Fiscal Year 1998-1999, as adopted by CB-53-
13 1998, to transfer funding authority to the Randall Farm Maintenance Facility project to construct
14 a facility to store materials and equipment; and

15 WHEREAS, the Commission has identified \$335,000 in operating funding that could be
16 used for this project; and

17 WHEREAS, the Commission has requested an amendment to the Prince George's County
18 portion of the Commission's Capital Budget for Fiscal Year 1998-1999, as adopted by CB-53-
19 1998, to transfer funding authority to the Rural Legacy Acquisition project to acquire properties
20 along the Patuxent River in the southern portion of the County; and

21 WHEREAS, the Commission has identified \$1,500,000 in funding from the State of
22 Maryland that could be used for this project; and

1 WHEREAS, the Commission has requested an amendment to the Prince George's County
2 portion of the Commission's Capital Budget for Fiscal Year 1998-1999, as adopted by CB-53-
3 1998, to transfer funding authority to the Henson Creek Golf Course project for road
4 improvements at the course required by the County's Department of Public Works and
5 Transportation; and

6 WHEREAS, the Commission has identified \$105,000 in undesignated fee-in-lieu monies
7 that could be used for this project; and

8 WHEREAS, the Commission has requested an amendment to the Prince George's County
9 portion of the Commission's Capital Budget for Fiscal Year 1998-1999, as adopted by CB-53-
10 1998, to transfer funding authority to the Fort Washington Area Recreation Study project for
11 design work for a community center in the Fort Washington/Accokeek area; and

12 WHEREAS, the Commission has identified \$200,000 in operating funding that could be
13 used for this project; and

14 WHEREAS, the capital budget as adopted constitutes the total appropriation for projects
15 previously authorized; and

16 WHEREAS, the County Council has conducted a public hearing on July 13, 1999 on the
17 proposed amendments having given reasonable notice thereof.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
19 County, Maryland, that the Fiscal Year 1998-1999 Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning
20 Commission Capital Budget is revised to include the four amendments as shown in Attachment
21 "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Fiscal Year 1999 funds for these projects shall be
23 derived from the State (\$1,500,000), operating budget transfers (\$535,000) and a developer
24 contribution (\$105,000).

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be retroactively effective to
26 June 30, 1999.
