Committee Voted: No Recommendation, 3-0-1 (In favor: Council Members MacKinnon, Scott Wilson. Abstain: Council Member Gourdine).

At the Committee worksession on CR-47-1996, the Principal Counsel to the District Council advised the Committee that due to the unusual and contested nature of this case and the potential legal implications that the worksession would be recorded. This however would not be a part of the official record on this case. Anything intended as evidence would have to be repeated at the Public

Hearing. Committee members expressed concern for legal procedure, unnecessary duplication of testimony and fairness issues. Committee then decided not to receive testimony or proceed further with the worksession and subsequently voted for No Recommendation on CR-47-1996.
