This Resolution will provide Supplementary Appropriations of Federal, State and other funds in the amount of \$12,339,190 for Fiscal Year 2014. The additional appropriations will support new and/or grant program efforts for the following nine (9) County agencies:

The Office of Law has reviewed this Resolution and finds it to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its adoption.

Total Program Spending......\$223,627,939

The adoption of CR-43-2014 will have a positive fiscal impact on the County FY 2014 Budget by appropriating an additional \$12,339,190 in Outside Source funding. The grant awards will have an adverse fiscal impact on the County in the amount of \$1,413,545, but the additional revenue received from the grant awards far outweighs the adverse impact as a result of the County Cash.
