A RESOLUTION concerning		
	Military Leave	
For the purpose o	f repealing the termination provisions of Section 4, Chapter 9, Laws of Prince	
George's County, Maryland 2002 (CB-1-2002) concerning military leave.		
WHEREAS	, on January 18, 2002, the County Executive submitted a proposed amendment	
to each Salary Schedule of the Salary Plan of the County, which was considered by the Council		
as CR-2-2002; and		
WHEREAS, the proposed amendments became effective on March 20, 2002, in accordance		
with Section 903 of the County Charter; and		
WHEREAS	, the benefits provided in the amendments to the several Salary Schedules	
expressed in CR-2-2002 expire one calendar year from the date of its adoption; and		
WHEREAS	, amendments to Section 16-223 – Military Leave - of the County Code were	
enacted into law by CB-1-2002, and became effective on July 1, 2002; and		
WHEREAS	, Section 4 of CB-1-2002 provided that the leave donation program and the	
supplement to military pay for employees who are no longer in a military leave with pay status		
created by CB-1-2002 shall terminate on February 24, 2003; and		
WHEREAS	, the national emergency that was declared in response to the terrorist attacks	
upon the United States of America on September 11, 2001, continues and requires the		
mobilization of additional members of the National Guard of the United States or the Reserves to		
active duty that will extend beyond the expiration of military leave benefits provided in the		
amendments enacted by CB-1-2002; and

1	WHEREAS, it is necessary to continue the military leave benefits provided by CB-1-2002		
2	and CR-2-2002 until legislation can be considered and enacted into law by the County Council		
3	that permanently extends military leave benefits to employees ordered to extended active duty		
4	for national emergencies; and		
5	WHEREAS, Section 1017 of the County Charter provides that a resolution has the force		
6	and effect of a law of a temporary or administrative character.		
7	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's		
8	County, Maryland, that Section 4 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Prince George's County, Maryland		
9	2002 concerning the amendment of Section 16-223 - Military Leave - Prince George's County		
10	Code, be and the same is hereby repealed:		
11	[SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the leave donation program and the		
12	supplement to military leave pay for employees who are no longer in a military leave with		
13	pay status created by this Act shall terminated on February 24, 2003.]
