This legislation transfers \$9.4 million in appropriation authority between certain departments and

Non-Departmental in the General Fund. The Fiscal Year 2025 General Fund Budget as expressed in CB-45-2024 and amended in CB-22-2025 and CB-54-2025 remains \$4,730,854,600.

This legislation reallocates \$9.4 million to cover the shortfalls in Non-Departmental due to unanticipated costs.
