The Committee discussed the purpose and responsibilities of the proposed Task Force. In response to a number of concerns, it was agreed that two groups would be established through the resolution. First, an Interagency Work Group, consisting of Council Members, a County Executive representative, and commissioners of the M-NCPPC and WSSC, would be created to advise the Council regarding development of the Growth Policy and Economic Development Plan. In addition, a 17-member Task Force would be established to advise the Interagency Work Group. The Task Force may also solicit public input and provide feedback to the Work Group on the various

proposals.

The Committee also amended the membership of the Task Force to include a member of the Sierra Club and two citizens, and reduced the number of former deputy CAOs to one.
