	RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

The enactment of a certain Ordinance of the City of College Park.

FOR the purpose of approving the enactment of Section 26-9L of the City of College Park Code concerning off-street parking.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of College Park, pursuant to Section 26 of the City's Ordinances have the authority to enact ordinances related to off-street parking; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council, after a public hearing, enacted 26-9L of the City Code on the 26th day of February 1991; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance (attached hereto and incorporated herein as Attachment A, and hereinafter referred to as "the Ordinance") prohibits certain off-street parking of vehicles unless the said vehicle is parked on a space completely covered by asphalt,

brick, block, concrete, contained gravel, contained crushed stone or structurally sound porous materials; and

WHEREAS, Section 8-112.1 of Article 28 of the Maryland
Annotated Code authorized municipalities within the MarylandWashington Metropolitan District to enact ordinances affecting
parking on land zoned either residential or commercial for the
purpose of preserving, improving and protecting the general
character and design of lands within the corporate limits of the
municipality, provided that such ordinances impose stricter or
additional limitations or restrictions than are otherwise imposed by
County zoning regulations; and

WHEREAS, Article 28, Section 8-112.1 of the Maryland Annotated Code provides that such ordinance shall not be effective until approved by the County Council for Prince George's County; and

WHEREAS, the City of College Park, pursuant to Article 28, Section 8-112.1 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, has delivered a certified copy of the Ordinance to the District Council; and

WHEREAS, the County Council, sitting as the District Council, has determined that the Ordinance imposes restrictions on the storage or parking of vehicles on streets in residential areas that are in addition to those currently imposed by Subtitle 27 of the Prince George's County Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that Ordinance 90-0-5 of the City of College Park,

as represented in Attachment A to this Resolution, be and is hereby $\ensuremath{\mathtt{APPROVED}}.$
