**PUBLIC SAFETY AND FISCAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT**    Date: 7/15/98

Committee Vote: Favorable as amended, 4-0-1, (In favor: Council Members Estepp, Bailey, Scott and Wilson. Abstained: Hendershot).

This Resolution will approve the Charter of the Revenue Authority as required under CB-84-1997. The names of the initial members of the Authority will be inserted after Council's review and confirmation. (pp 3)

The County Executive noted that the provisions of the Charter are somewhat generic in nature because the specific procedures for the Authority will be contained in the regulations that will be submitted to the Council for approval once the Authority is established.

The legislation was amended to establish a deadline for the submission of operating regulations to the Council (pp 1, lines 24-25), to list the amount of compensation for the members, to require Council approval of any acquisition of property or assumption of operations from the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission and to require the General Counsel to maintain a close liaison with the County Attorney.

There should not be any negative fiscal impact on the County as a result of adopting CR-61-1998.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT**

The establishment of the Revenue Authority was authorized by CB-84-1997. This legislation will approve the Charter of the Revenue Authority.
