PUBLIC SAFETY AND FISCAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT Date: 3/6/97

This Resolution amends the Salary Plan in Salary Schedule I for the new Family Connection Division, Department of Family Services' bargaining unit, represented by AFSCME Local 2735 and reflects modifications of the collective bargaining agreement.

The highlights of the Salary Plan and the fiscal impact are included in CB-24-1997.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

This is companion legislation to the Council Bill to approve the initial collective bargaining agreement between Prince George's County and the Council 67, American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO and its affiliated Local 2735 covering employees in the Family Connection Division, Department of Family Services beginning in Fiscal Year 1997. This Salary Schedule reflects the terms of the agreement. The estimated fiscal impact will be provided by the Office of Management and Budget.
