- a. Town received a DHCD Community Legacy grant for \$100,000.
- b. Submitted two bond bill requests. Sidewalks on Hamilton and 47th Avenue for \$250,000 and Town Hall Expansion for \$300,000.
- c. Project charges \$50,000 for yoga, boot camp exercise, soccer, dance classes and Edmonston Day event.
- d. The staff is working on the continuance of the Food Composting program
