WHEREAS, In the PALMER PARK MEADOWS Project, HIP will construct nine new single family homes in Palmer Park and sell them to first time homebuyers earning 80 percent or

less of the area median income; and

WHEREAS, In the STREET SCHOLARSHIPS Program, HIP will provide educational scholarships to single adults in Palmer Park to assist them in learning business and employment skills; and

WHEREAS, HIP has applied to the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development (MD/DHCD) for approximately \$257,000 from the Community Legacy Program; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive expresses approval of the application, as described above; and
