**LEGISLATIVE HISTORY**HOUSING AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

Committee Vote: Favorable, 6-0-0, (In favor: Bell, Casula, Castaldi,

This resolution will establish a 10-member task force to study the possibilities of plastics recycling in Prince George's County. The task force will be required to report to the Council with an interim report on or before September 30, 1990. The final study and recommendations are due December 31, 1990.

The creation of a Plastics Recycling Task Force was requested by the Housing and Economic Development Committee during its review of CB-35-1990, which would have required drive-in and fast-food restaurants to recycle all plastic food and beverage containers.
