Committee Vote: Favorable as amended, 4-0-1 (In favor: Council Members Franklin,

Olson, Patterson and Toles. Abstain: Council Member Harrison)

CB-87-2013 was transmitted by the Planning Board for the Council's consideration. This legislation amends Subtitle 25 (Trees and Vegetation) under the Woodland and Wildlife Habitat Conservation Ordinance (WCO) to eliminate the need for a Letter of Exemption for projects within the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area (CBCA); to clarify why development applications in the CBCA are exempt from the WCO; and to clarify validity periods and expiration dates of approved Tree Conservation Plans.

Rana Hightower, Katina Shoulars, and Debra Borden, representing the Planning Board, were present to provide additional background concerning the purpose of the legislation and respond to questions. The Planning Board staff informed the committee that CB-87-2013 is amending the County Code to provide consistency with State law.

The Office of Law reviewed CB-87-2013 and determined that the bill is in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its enactment. A technical amendment was noted on page 2, line 7 to underline the word "to" after "is not required".

The committee voted favorable including an amendment to the title as suggested by the Legislative Officer to further clarify and provide notice that certain exemptions to submittal requirements are specified in the bill.
