SECTION	1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,

(a) Section	on 104.3 is amended to read as follows:
"104.3 Ins	spections. Subject to the limitations and conditions as hereinafter stated in this
Section, it shall	be the duty of the Code Official to make, or cause to be made, inspections as

often as necessary to determine the conditions of dwellings, multifamily dwellings, dwelling units, rooming houses, rooming units, and premises in order to safeguard the safety and welfare of the public under the provisions of this Code. Such inspections shall be made in response to citizen or official complaints or other reliable information or allegations of existing violations of the Code. Further, inspections of dwellings, dwelling units, rooming houses, rooming units, and premises shall be made on a systematic basis (e.g., house by house, block by block) in areas, communities, or neighborhoods when it is determined by the Code Official that such action is necessary to properly apply and enforce the provisions of this Code. An investigation unit shall be established to aid in the investigation of persistent and critical violations of this Code. The investigation unit shall consist of Department of Permitting, Inspections and Enforcement staff and an advisory supervisor from the Prince George's County Department of the Environment and the Revenue Authority. All reports of such inspections and investigations by the investigation unit shall be in writing and shall be certified by a responsible officer of such approved agency or by the responsible individual. The Code Official is authorized to engage such expert opinion as deemed necessary to report upon unusual technical issues that arise, subject to the approval of the appointing authority." SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this
