WHEREAS	5, Title 5, Subtitle 4 of the State Finance and Procurement Article of the
Annotated Code	of Maryland requires local jurisdictions to include priority preservation areas for
certification of lo	ocal preservation programs.

EXHIBIT 1 PURCHASE OF DEVELOPMENT RIGHTS PROGRAM REGULATIONS

10. Ranking. In order to effectuate the purposes of the PDR Program, parcels for which a conservation easement application have been received shall be ranked according to the criteria and point values assigned as provided below: C. Preservation of Natural Cultural and Scenic Resources. Parcel [adjacent] has direct access to a County or 3. state road 5 point 4. Parcel adjoins a Maryland Scenic Byway or a County designated Scenic or Historic Road 10 points G. Priority Preservation Area (PPA). The parcel is located outside a designated PPA 0 points 1. <u>2.</u> The parcel is located within a designated PPA 5 points <u>3.</u> The parcel is located within the PPA and considered to be in the "undeveloped portion" 15 points H. County Green Infrastructure Plan Parcel only contains land within a network gap 0 points <u>1.</u> Parcel contains 5 acres or more within an evaluation area 5 points <u>2.</u> Parcel contains five (5) acres or more within a regulated area 10 points <u>3.</u>
