



1 expected to be available and the institutional structure expected to carry out the Consolidated  
2 Plan; and

3 WHEREAS, the Consolidated Plan outlines measures designed to increase homeownership,  
4 reduce barriers to affordable housing, promote fair housing, reduce predatory lending and  
5 foreclosure prevention, reduce the hazards of lead-based paint, address the needs of public  
6 housing, and presents an anti-poverty strategy; and

7 WHEREAS, the Consolidated Plan estimates the amount of federal entitlement funds  
8 projected for proposed housing and community development activities (including public  
9 facilities, economic development, public services, and community revitalization) in order to  
10 achieve the goals and carry out the objectives over a five year period; and

11 WHEREAS, citizens, government agency representatives, and interested nonprofit and for  
12 profit organizations were invited to present their views and concerns on the issues affecting the  
13 low and moderate-income households, homeless populations, and non-homeless special needs  
14 populations; and

15 WHEREAS, the specific objectives in the Consolidated Plan represent the policies  
16 articulated by public officials, the views expressed by citizens and interest groups, and are based  
17 on factual data collected and analyzed by researchers; and

18 WHEREAS, under the terms of Subtitle 15A of the Prince George's County Code, the  
19 County Council duly advertised and conducted a public hearing on the Consolidated Plan for  
20 Housing and Community Development: FY 2011-2015; and

21 WHEREAS, the County Council, in recognition of public testimony and on the basis of its  
22 review and analysis of the Consolidated Plan, finds that said Consolidated Plan generally  
23 conforms to the provisions and intent of Subtitle 15A, and accordingly desires to endorse and  
24 approve the Consolidated Plan in order to continue to receive federal entitlement funds from the  
25 U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development; and

26 WHEREAS, Attachment "A" includes the Consolidated Plan for Housing and Community  
27 Development: FY 2011-2015.

28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's  
29 County, Maryland, that the Prince George's County FY 2011-2015 Consolidated Plan for  
30 Housing and Community Development is hereby approved as described in Attachment "A".

31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon adoption of the Resolution, it shall be transmitted

1 to the County Executive by the Clerk of the Council to submit the approved Consolidated Plan to  
2 the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, along with all assurances contained  
3 therein, to act as necessary in connection with the submission, and to provide such additional  
4 information to HUD as may be required.
