WHEREAS, in 2022, the Maryland General Assembly passed HB425 and SB387, bills that criminalize the possession of unserialized firearms, otherwise known as ghost guns or privately made firearms; and

WHEREAS, this resolution recognizes Maryland State Law which states that possessing a ghost guns and the failure to comply with rules and regulations is punishable by up to two years imprisonment and a fine of up to \$10,000 per firearm; and

WHEREAS, the Maryland ghost gun law was promulgated on March 1st, 2023; and
