#### TRANSPORTATION, HOUSING AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE

**Date 11/13/2007**

Committee Vote: Favorable, 5-0 (In favor: Council Members Dernoga, Olson, Campos, Harrington and Turner)

Staff summarized the purpose of the resolution. CR-52-2007 draft 2 amends the Prince Georges County FY 2003, FY 2004, FY 2005, FY 2006 and FY 2007 Annual Action Plan for Housing Community Development to reprogram Community Development Block Grant projects and project funding plans to amend the FY 2008 Annual Action Plan to approve new Community Development Block Grant projects and project funding plans, and generally relating to the Housing and Community Development.

Attachment A of CR-52-2007 draft 2 are funds eligible for reprogramming totaling \$1,216,876.64. Attachment B of CR-52-2007 draft 2 are funds that are also available for reprogramming and considered "open" totaling \$1,430,000. Attachment A + Attachment B = Attachment C which is equal to \$2,646,877.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:**

The County wishes to reprogram the funds from the cancelled (“Community Development Block Grant”) CDBG activities, in which the subrecipient withdrew voluntarily or it was determined they were unable to meet the terms of their CDBG agreement, described in Attachment A and the “OPEN” CDBG activities, in which the activity was approved in a previous Annual Action Plan (“AAP”) and the subrecipient is now unable to complete the contracted activity, described in Attachment B to fund the new, eligible CDBG activities described in Attachment C which were not originally funded or described in previously approved AAPs but are critical to achieving the Goals and Objectives of the County’s Consolidated Plan.
