RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning
2 Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission – Prince George’s County Members -
3 Appointment and Geographic Balance

4 For the purpose of addressing the geographic distribution and balance of the membership of the
5 Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission and confirming the reappointment of
6 William M. Doerner as a member.

7 WHEREAS, Section 15-103 of the Land Use Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland
8 requires that, in making and approving appointments to the Maryland-National Capital Park and
9 Planning Commission, the County Council and County Executive shall attempt to provide
10 reasonable geographic balance with respect to the places of residence of the members; and

11 WHEREAS, Section 15-103 of the Land Use Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland
12 further requires that the appointment resolution for each appointment shall describe the resulting
13 geographic distribution and provide appropriate explanations; and

14 WHEREAS, the County Executive has duly nominated William M. Doerner, a resident of
15 Hyattsville; and

16 WHEREAS, a public hearing on the nomination and confirmation of William M. Doerner
17 has been held; and

18 WHEREAS, the remaining four members of the Commission from Prince George’s County
19 are residents of Bowie, Fort Washington, Mitchellville, and Temple Hills respectively.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
21 County, Maryland, that, with the reappointment of William M. Doerner to the Maryland-
22 National Capital Park and Planning Commission, there continues to be reasonable geographic

1 distribution with respect to the places of residence of the members of the Commission from
2 Prince George’s County.

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that William M. Doerner is hereby confirmed as a
4 member of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission with a term expiring
5 June 15, 2022.
