**REPORT:** Committee Vote: No Action Taken (Chair Oriadha, Vice Chair Olson, Council Members Adams-Stafford, Adams, Blegay, Burroughs, Dernoga, Fisher, Harrison, Hunter, Ivey)

The County Council Committee of the Whole met on March 10, 2026, to consider the appointment of Ms. Brittnay Jenkins as a member of the Prince George's County Planning Board of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission (M-NCPPC).

On March 4, 2026, the County Executive, Aishia Braveboy, transmitted a letter to the County Council in accordance with Land Use Article Section 15-103(b) of the Annotated Code of Maryland, and Sections 322, 402, and 504 of the Charter of Prince George's County, appointing Ms. Brittnay Jenkins to the Planning Board.

Mr. Devin Martin, Deputy Chief of Staff from the Office of the County Executive, presented Ms. Jenkins' qualifications. A resident of Brentwood, she is set to serve on the Planning Board for a term that expires on June 15, 2028, replacing Ms. Shaunise A. Washington.

Mr. Martin emphasized that Ms. Jenkins has experience working with complex systems, large datasets, and multi-stakeholder initiatives. She holds a Master of Science in Business Analytics from American University, a Master of Arts in Sociology, and a Bachelor of Science in Mass Communications with a concentration in Public Relations from Minnesota State University, Mankato.

County Executive Braveboy believes that Ms. Jenkins' perspective will help foster balanced development, strengthen neighborhoods, promote environmental stewardship, and create equitable economic opportunities for residents across the County. No action was taken on the appointment.
