Supplementary Appropriations in the Approved Fiscal Year 2021 Capital Budget For the purpose of providing supplementary appropriations to the Medical Unit Renovation and Expansion project (4.56.0005), Suitland Manor (8.90.0003) and Systemic Replacement 2 (4.77.0009); and amending the Approved Fiscal Year 2021 – 2026 Capital Improvement Program with regard to expenditures and financing beyond the budget year.

WHEREAS, the Charter of Prince George's County, Maryland provides for the adoption of the County budget, which includes the capital budget and capital program; and

WHEREAS, pursuant CB-24-2020, the County Budget, known as the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance of Prince George's County for Fiscal Year 2021, which includes the Fiscal Year 2021-2026 Capital Improvement Program - Fiscal Year 2021 Capital Budget was adopted; and

WHEREAS, the Approved Fiscal Year 2021-2026 Capital Improvement Program sets forth the plan of the County to receive and expend funds for capital projects during the fiscal year covered by the capital budget and the next succeeding five fiscal years thereafter and also the means of financing said projects; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 815 of the Charter for Prince George's County, Maryland, the County Council, upon recommendation of the County Executive, may, by legislative act, make additional or supplementary appropriations from revenue received from anticipated sources but in excess of budget estimates therefor, from revenue received from sources not anticipated in the budget for the current fiscal year, and from any prior year's available and uncommitted fund balance;

WHEREAS, additional appropriations as provided, herein, and certain additional revenue have been identified; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive deems it desirable to provide additional appropriations for the Medical Unit Renovation and Expansion project (4.56.0005), Suitland Manor (8.90.0003) and Systemic Replacement 2 (4.77.0009); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 815 of the Charter, the County Executive recommends that these supplementary appropriations be made.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Fiscal Year 2021 Approved Capital Budget is hereby amended to provide supplementary appropriations as follows:
