legacy projects; and		
WHEREAS, Section 6-206 (b)(1) of the Housing and Community Development Article,		
Annotated Code of Maryland, provides that the Community Legacy Board may not approve an		
application for parti	cipation in the Community Legacy Program unless the application is	
approved by the pol	itical subdivision; and	
WHEREAS, H	IP is applying to the Maryland Department of Housing and Community	
Development, Community Legacy Program, for funds to carry out its "Acquisition and Rehab,"		
project (the "Project"	") in the Palmer Park and Bladensburg communities (collectively, the "Area"),	
as described in Attac	chment "A" and incorporated by reference; and	
WHEREAS, the Project promotes the rehabilitation of abandoned homes, home ownership,		
and education, thereby contributing to the reinvestment and revitalization in the Area; and		
WHEREAS, the Area is located within a priority funding area under Section 5-7B-02 of the		

Smart Growth Act and the Project will conform to the local zoning code; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive, by his signature, expresses approval of the application submitted by Housing Initiative Partnership, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, hereby approves the application of Housing Initiative Partnership, Inc. submitted to the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development for participation in the Community Legacy Program in the approximate amount of \$500,000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to the Secretary of the Department of Housing and Community Development of the State of Maryland for consideration by the Community Legacy Board.
