LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

Committee of the Whole Report Date: October 16, 1990

Committee Vote: No recommendation, 5-0 (Council Members Bell, Castaldi, MacKinnon, Mills and Pemberton)

The Arlington County Hotline was started in June, 1990 and did not require any additional cost or personnel. During the ninety day period they have sent out approximately 16 letters to individuals reported to have been parked illegally in the handicapped parking space.

The financial costs and benefits (revenues) associated with the adoption and implementation of CB-117-1990 cannot be reasonably determined from the information made available for review.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

This legislation would direct the Chief of Police to establish a dedicated telephone hotline to receive citizen complaints of persons illegally using reserved handicapped parking spaces. Regulations to implement the hotline would be promulgated on or before January 1, 1990.
