3 For the purpose of authorizing the Director of Finance to set a fee for copies of tax bills

4 BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

5 SUBTITLE 10. FINANCE AND TAXATION.

6 Section 10-139,

7 The Prince George's County Code

8 (1999 Edition, 2002 Supplement).

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
 10 Maryland, that Section 10-139 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby
 11 repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

12 **SUBTITLE 10. FINANCE AND TAXATION.**

13 **DIVISION 2. DIRECTOR OF FINANCE.**

14 **Sec. 10-139. Certified statement of taxes; liability; tax bills.**

15 * * * * *

16 (b) The Director and any designee authorized by him, at any time after taxes have been
 17 assessed for any year, shall furnish to any taxpayer, upon demand, a bill or bills showing the
 18 assessment upon each piece of real estate assessed to the taxpayer and the amount of the taxes
 19 thereon. The bill need not show the amount of interest due, if any, but shall contain a statement
 20 of the date from and after which interest is or will become due and the rate of such interest. Any
 21 person or corporation may obtain a copy of a tax bill upon payment of a fee [of One Dollar

1 (\$1.00)] as set by the Director. A copy of a tax bill may be obtained, without charge, by any
2 governmental agency, or by an individual taxpayer for his own property.

3 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)
4 calendar days after it becomes law.
